A. President

- Parent feedback has been positive so far

- Grant Writing for Renaissance
 - Two parents have reached out to volunteer to do grant writing for the school.
 - Jenny Henry will work with them to see which grants we want to go after so we can get started on them.
 - Jenny and parent volunteers need to run grants by Trena for approval/keep in the loop.

• There are some grants that students can be involved in during the writing process.

• Parent Survey

- There seems to be a need to hear about how parents are feeling (long term goals of the school, how parents are feeling as we phase back to full time school, etc.)
- During pick up at the end of the day was a time when we used to get feedback from parents and since we don't have that this year, so far, we'd still like to hear how people are feeling.
- Every survey has outliers, but we can extract a lot of valuable information and get a good pulse on the school.

• Cap Elim family voyage

- Tiffany is getting the information flier out asap for parents to start signing up.
 Cost will be \$85/per person.
- This is a great opportunity for school families to build as crew and to be able to get a better understanding of what voyage is like for our students on voyage.

B. Vice-President

• Parents Night Out

- It has been difficult to find a restaurant that could safely accommodate a gathering and may not be feasible with current gathering restrictions.
- Mattney Park gazebo is open and could be a potential option for parents to bring their chairs and their dinners and to gather socially-distanced
- It would be our first week back from Fall Break/early November (if we do go forward with it)
- This may be a good topic to put on our Parent Survey-to see what the interest may be from the parent community

C. Treasurer

- We are also able to support all the staff members who want to attend the upcoming EL conference, any teacher/staff member who wants to go was able to be registered.
- Everything's within the budget that was approved in the Spring; if anything falls outside the previously approved budget, Brittnee will make a motion to approve for the Board to vote on.

V. Old Business

A. Red envelope

- This was a great opportunity last year to show appreciation for all staff during the holidays. All staff members got a check based on parents donating to a school-wide fundraiser drive
- Last year we also had the auction crew baskets due at the same time.
- Last year the concern was that with this going on at the same time as holiday family adoptions it seemed like a lot all at once.
 - Allison is hoping to get rolling out on holiday adoptions by late October/early
 November
 - Allison has already started fundraising
 - All family gifts will be due back to Allison by December 5th.
 - Hoping to have all the families contacted by the end of October

- Need to increase communication about the different acts of service and giving that the Renaissance community participates in during the holiday season.
 - Get this out in the early November
 - Tiffany will be working on a letter and will run it by Allison to make sure the language/expectations is consistent
- Red envelopes will go out after Thanksgiving break on November 30th.

B. Fundraising

- Should we go forward with a "Write-a-Check" campaign?
- Some local schools have tried on campaigns but they haven't been entirely successful and haven't raised much with online auction fundraising.
- We collectively want to avoid going to local businesses to ask for donations because so many businesses are struggling and have always supported us in years past.
- We'd like to just move forward with a "Write-a-Check" and parents can donate if they want to and if they're able to.
- We would focus on this campaign in late March to best suit our families. (In lieu of our usual celebration).
- Trena and Allison are going to look into a specific need in the school to direct our fundraising goals towards for the campaign.
- Allie will reach out to the auction committee to let them know of our plans.
- We are still not able to utilize our parking spots and the spots that were bought during last year's auction due to district regulations of families on school property.
 - We are so thankful for our committees who are doing so much brainstorming!

VI. New Business

A. Halloween Parties

- The Positive Culture Committee really wants to help our students have a nice Halloween experience
- Students will come to school wearing their costumes and with their day's clothes underneath. Students will have a socially distanced, outdoor parade around the perimeter that will be live streamed.
- Teachers will be finding ways to celebrate the day during class
